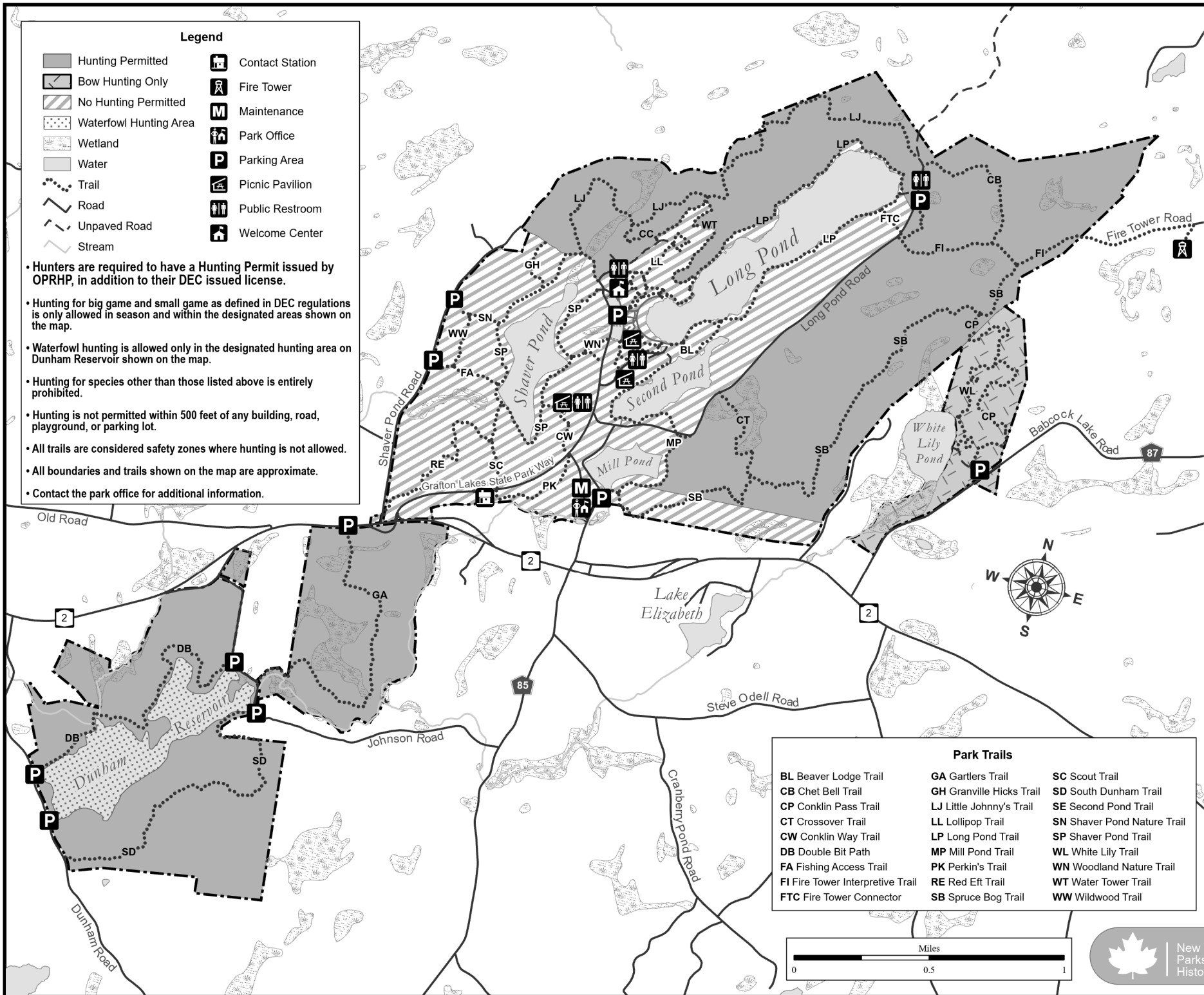

- Hunters are required to have a Hunting Permit issued by OPRHP, in addition to their DEC issued license.
- Hunting for big game and small game as defined in DEC regulations is only allowed in season and within the designated areas shown on the map.
- Waterfowl hunting is allowed only in the designated hunting area on Dunham Reservoir shown on the map.
- Hunting for species other than those listed above is entirely prohibited.
- Hunting is not permitted within 500 feet of any building, road, playground, or parking lot.
- All trails are considered safety zones where hunting is not allowed.
- All boundaries and trails shown on the map are approximate.
